The name and look were chosen after careful consideration and consultation with stakeholders and members. The name better reflects what we represent and what we aim for: better health for animals. It strengthens the association's vision to communicate the important contribution the animal health sector brings to society, to help create a healthier world through an innovative, responsible and sustainable animal health sector and to reinforce itself as the global voice of the veterinary medicine sector.

To mark this launch, a number of tools have been developed which can be accessed here from 1 June onwards:

- A short video from our President explaining our vision,
- <u>A microsite</u> setting out our contribution in areas like: emerging diseases, zoonoses, enough safe food in the future, new technologies, vaccines and innovation, pets and antibiotics,
